The Common Council met with Mayor William McKean for a regular meeting on Monday, February 12, 2018 at 7:30 p.m. in the Council Chambers at City Hall according to the posted notice. Councilmen Gregg Sprunger, Curtis Wurster, Ron Dull, Mark Wynn and Philip Provost were present, along with Attorney Dave Baumgartner and Clerk-Treasurer Gwen Maller.

Councilman Gregg Sprunger, opened the meeting with the pledge of allegiance and Mayor McKean gave the invocation.

Minutes

On a motion by Phil Provost and a second by Ron Dull, the minutes of the January 22, 2018 meeting were unanimously approved.

Claims

On a motion by Gregg Sprunger and a second by Curtis Wurster, the claims were unanimously approved for payment.

Attorney Comments

Attorney Dave Baumgartner reported that he has begun work on the Interlocal Agreement with Adams County for the Parr Road project. He stated that it will need to go to their attorney for review.

Mayor Comments

Mayor McKean reported that a pre-construction meeting for the Parr Road project was held on February 8, 2018. Representatives from Commonwealth Engineering and the 3D Company met with City personnel. **Industries along the project route were also in attendance.**

Mayor McKean informed the Council that City offices will be closed Monday, February 19th in observance of Presidents Day. Monday's sanitation route will be run on Tuesday. The compost site will be closed Monday.

Councilmen Comments

Councilman Curtis Wurster asked if the timing at the stop light at the intersection of Main and U.S. 27 had been recently changed. It seems to stay green or red a lot longer. Councilman Ron Dull stated that he would contact his brother who works for INDOT and see what can be done.

There being no other business to come before the Council and upon a motion duly made to adjourn by Curtis Wurster and seconded by Gregg Sprunger, adjournment followed.
