- Garden-Lawn Vegetation

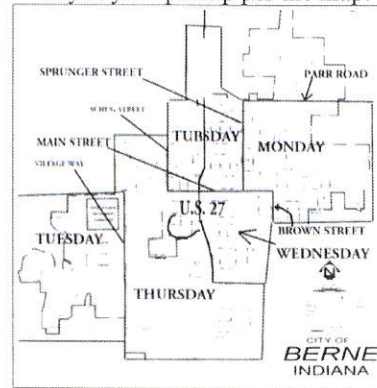
Materials That Will Not Be Allowed

- No Appliances, Cardboard
- No Plastics, Cans, House Trash
- No Commercial Products
- No Wood, Lumber, Demo. Material
- Do Not Leave Any Materials in Trash Bags

2019 Trash Pickup Schedules

Place trash curbside by 7 am on the day of your pickup per the map:



Heavy Trash Pickup

Spring – week of April 22nd

Fall – week of September 23rd

Place items curbside the morning of your regular trash pickup. (No hazardous materials allowed) see: <http://adamscountyswmd.com/>

Limbs & Branches: Every Friday
March-November. As needed
December-February

City Wide Grass /Leaf /Garden Waste Pickup: Every Thursday from April 4th-Sept 26th. Place in proper open containers

From Oct. 7th - Dec. 5th, place grass/leaves/garden waste on the pavement for vacuum pickup. (See route map on right)

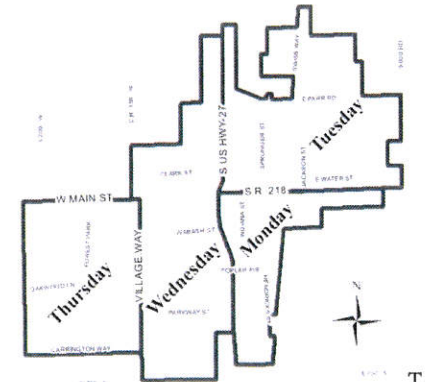
When mowing, do not blow grass on city streets. Grass on streets creates a safety hazard and clogs city storm drains. Thank you

Berne's Recycle Center South US 27 at Simon Unit Step

Use the lane on the north side and follow directions. Open Mondays 8:30 AM-5:30 PM
The center is closed any Monday that is a legal holiday, but will be open on Tuesday of that week
